The Book Peddler Guidelines for Community Request

Wright Library's book bike, The Book Peddler, can be scheduled to appear at community events in Oakwood. A completed reservation form is required and must be submitted at least two weeks before the date of the event. Forms can be dropped off at the library or emailed to reference@wrightlibrary.org. Confirmation of the Book Peddler's appearance at an event will be given within three business days after receipt of the request. Questions can be directed to Brian Potts, Operations Coordinator.

Guidelines:

- Requests must be made at least two weeks before the date of the event.
- The Book Peddler can be reserved for 1, 1.5, or 2 hours.
- Events must be within easy riding distance of the Library (as determined by the Library).
- A level space to park and set up the Book Peddler must be available.
- Limitations on availability include previous commitments, staff availability, and the weather.
- Book Peddler appearances will be canceled due to inclement weather and the forecast of 30% or greater chance of precipitation.
- The Book Peddler is available for community events, which are public in nature, but not necessarily open to all.
- An event with limited attendance, i.e. school events or ticketed nonprofit events can be scheduled with Library approval.
- Examples of events for which the Book Peddler is available: block parties, business or nonprofit sponsored events.
- There can be no charge for access to the Book Peddler.

The materials included with the Book Peddler will be selected by Wright Library librarians; however, some customization is available.

Customization options include:

- Age range of materials
- Type of material, i.e. fiction, nonfiction, genres, subjects
- Formats, i.e. books, audiobooks, movies
